SERVE TARGETS

Although Sofia won both sets, the first set was close (7-5), while the second set was decisive (6-0).

In the first set, 42% (129 out of 307) of all points ended with Sofia hitting an unforced error. She hit 11 of those "Minus" shots from the Neutral Tactical Position.

Meanwhile, only 6% (14 out of 207) of the points in the first set ended with Julia hitting a "Plus" (winner or forcing) shot. In short, Julia had no weapons that were hurting Sofia; yet, because of Sofia's 28 "Minus" shots, the first set was close.

In the second set, 30% (13 out of 43) of all points ended with Sofia hitting an unforced error. (Much better than first set, but still a high percentage.) In the second set, Sofia cut her "Minus" shots from the Neutral Tactical Position down (from 11 in the first set) to only 3.

Meanwhile, only 2 shots in the entire second set ended with Julia hitting a "Plus" shot. Again, Julia had no weapons that were hurting Sofia.
